CASE STUDY:

DROPPING PROFITABILITY AT ELECTROTECH COMPANY

ElectroTech Company was started in the year 2015 by Mr. Tom as a medium-sized manufacturing firm that produces electronic devices. The company was known for producing innovative and high-quality electronic devices and had been experiencing consistent growth for over five years (between 2015 to 2020). However, after their latest product launch in 2020, ElectroTech encountered several challenges that have led to decreased profitability over the last two years and the management team is concerned about this problem. Mr. Tom (the C.E.O) decided to hire a researcher to find the route course of the problem and the following findings were reported: That there was lack of a clear planning making employees to interpret priorities differently due to lack of clear direction; that the company suffered from ineffective organizational structure leading to duplicated efforts which resulted to unnecessary costs, increased resource utilization, and a decrease in overall efficiency; that there was weak leadership at departmental level where departmental heads have failed to effectively guide, inspire, and support their teams leading to low productivity; that there was poor quality control leading to poorquality products being released into the market, leading to widespread customer dissatisfaction and a sharp decline in market share, which resulted to a drop in profitability and that there were poor communication channels leading to delays in decision-making processes causing missed opportunities and decreased profitability.
