- a) Mr. Mbagaya the Operations Manager is meeting a group of University students specializing in Operations Management. He has been asked to present on the theme of Emerging trends in Operations Management. Explain emerging trends in Operations Management that Mr. Mbagaya should include in his presentation. (6 Marks)
- b) Michigan Inc. have concluded carrying out negotiation with one of their potential key suppliers. They are very keen to ensure the success of the contract through monitoring and evaluation of the contract by ensuring that responsibilities are carefully assigned to the right people. Outline the responsibilities that should be assigned to Anne Marie who is to act as the Contract Manager for the duration of the signed contract. (6 Marks)
- c) Kenmap, a retail business is unsuccessful in having an amicable solution to a contractual dispute with Mr. P, who is one of their key suppliers of toys. Mrs. Patel, the Retail Manager with Kenmap is worried on the exposure the dispute might put on their business. Mrs. Patel wants John Mark the Supply Chain Manager to explain to her the potential outcome of the stalemate. Highlight the points that John Mark should include in his write up on result of an amicable solution to a contractual relationship with the supplier.

- Andrew, a student of Operations Management is interviewing for a Role in Product Ideation. He is convinced that a question on the benefits having an effective product idea is likely to feature during the interview. He approaches Ben, a Career Guidance professional for help. Describe FIVE key benefits of developing an effective product idea that the Consultant should include in the discussion with Andrew. (5 Marks)

The Contract Manager with XYZ believes it is the right time to carry out a Post Implementation Review of the Contract. - b) Mrs. Irene the Maintenance Manager wants support from the Technical Manager on ensuring on time maintenance of equipment. With examples discuss in detail the different types of plant maintenance that Irene should include in her discussion with the Technical Manager. (5 Marks)
- c) Ben has been appointed to the newly created role of Director of Production. He is reviewing the benefits that production planning carries with it to the business. Discuss the benefits of production planning and control that Ben should review. (5 Marks)
- d) Martin the Research & Development Manager is planning to develop and launch a new product. Explain key stages in the product design and development process that Martin must include in order to have a successful launch of his new product. (5 Marks)
